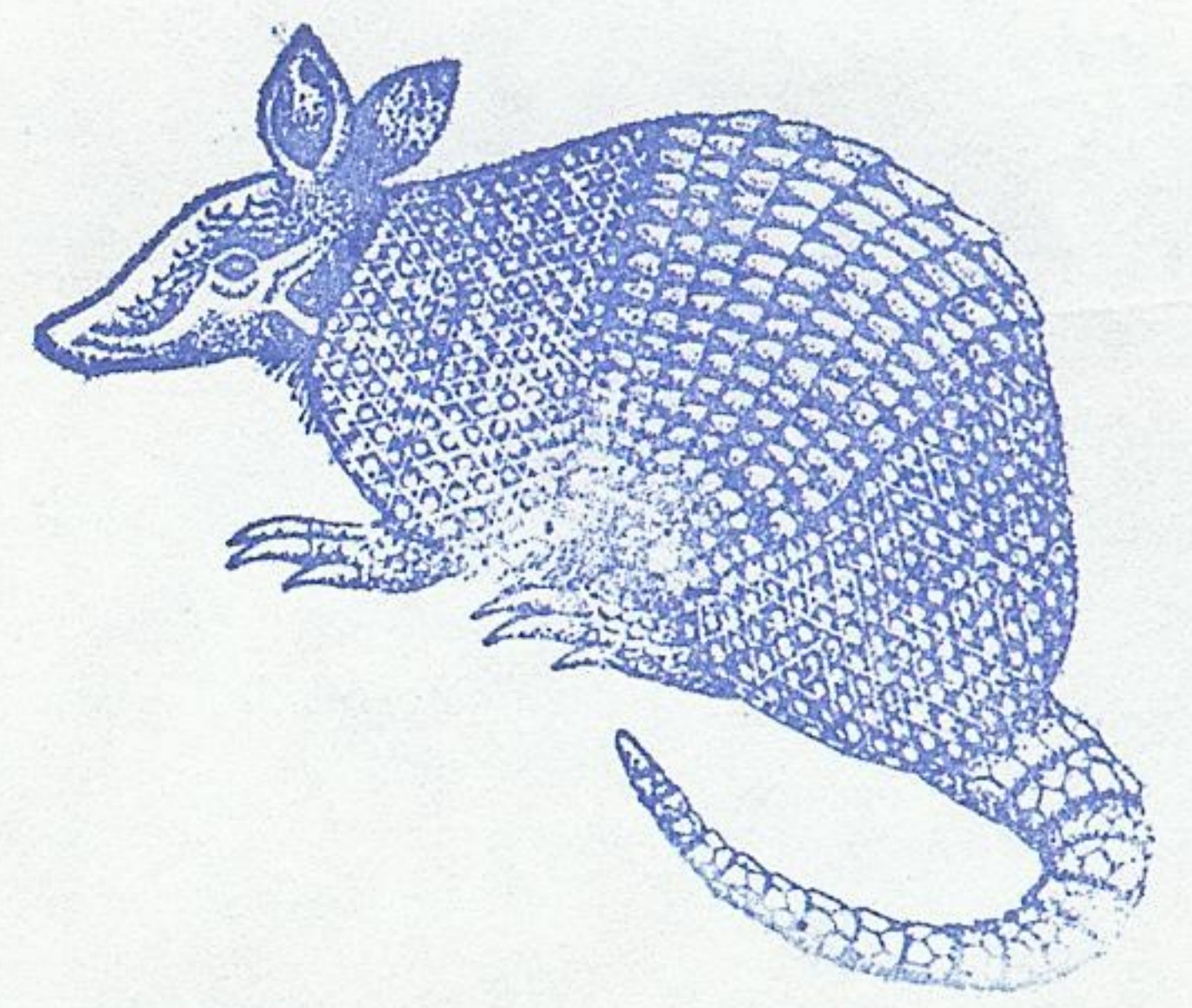


ARMADILLO ANNOUNCEMENTS
