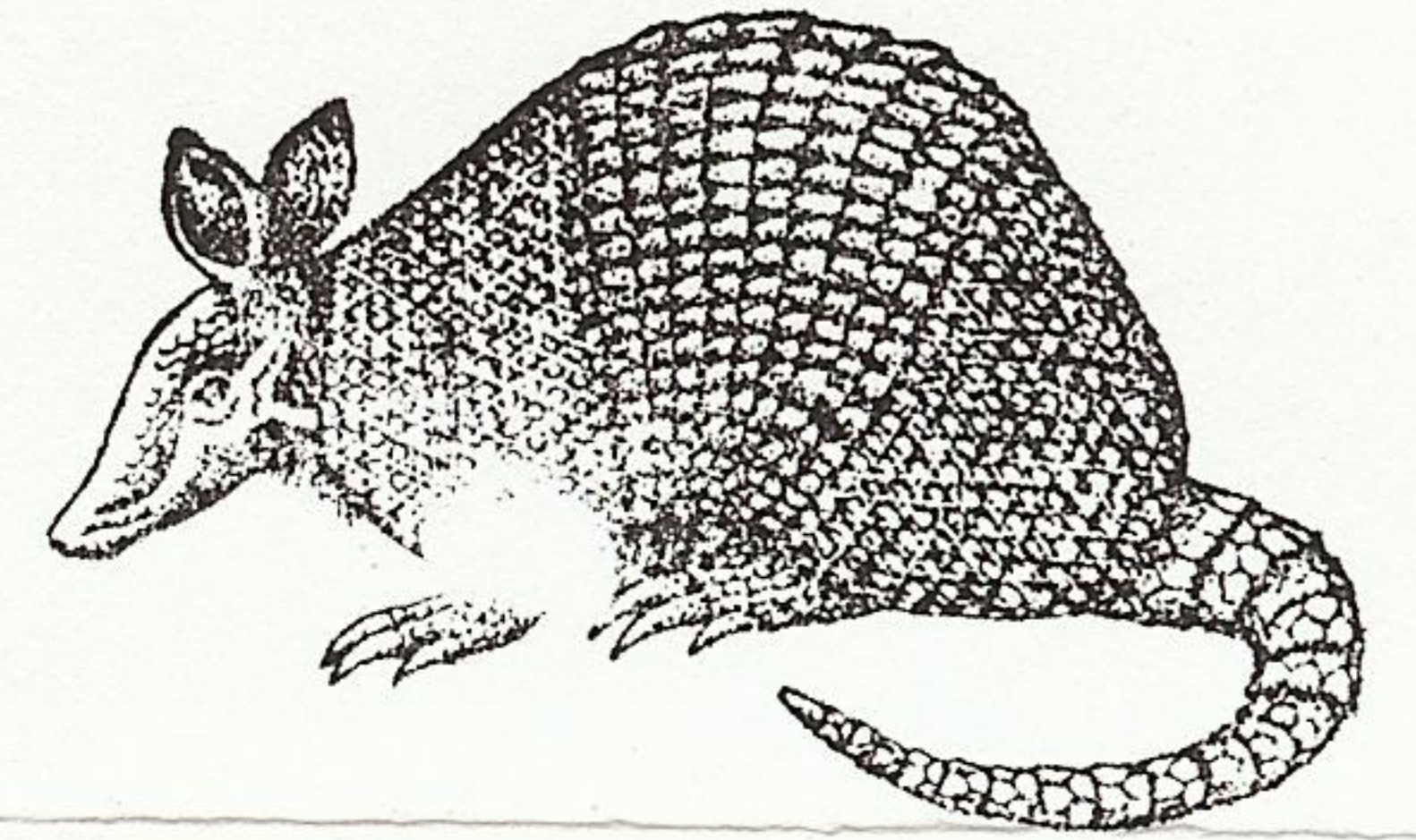
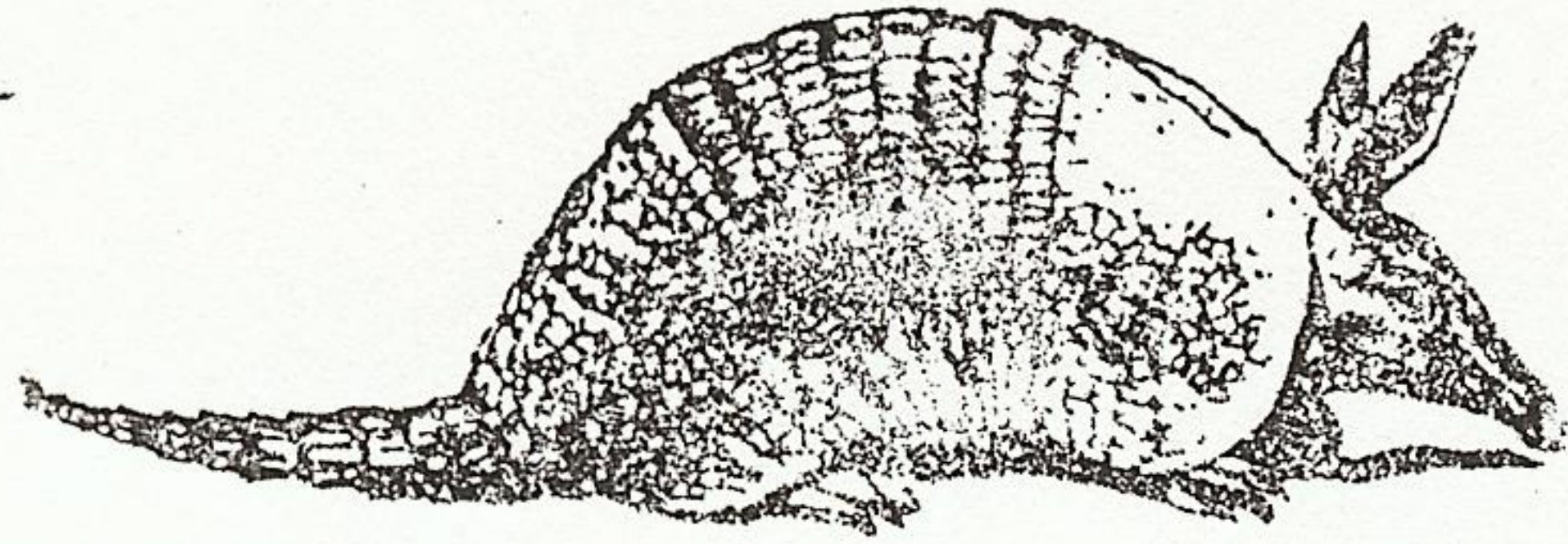


The (potentially) Last Armadillo Club Luncheon
